On June 23, 2017, CIBC announced that it completed the acquisition of Chicago-based PrivateBancorp, Inc. and its subsidiary, The PrivateBank, for approximately US\$5 billion. The transaction value will be paid with approximately US\$2.4 billion in cash and approximately 32.3 million CIBC shares.
